This book is a collection of stories that highlights the challenges faced by nine Wyoming individuals and three citizen groups, including Lynn Estelle Dickey, who is also known as "Joan of Arc on a steel stallion." These stories detail how these people demonstrated courage, resilience, and strength in navigating difficult circumstances, such as risking their careers, enduring public disapproval, and facing character defamation. The book aims to inspire readers by showcasing the remarkable moments of courage exhibited by these individuals when it mattered most.
